She attended public schools in Queens, New York and continued her college education in Newark, New Jersey. She lived in New Jersey up until 1995 and had resided in Pennsylvania until her death. She was an employee at Odgen in New Jersey and held the position as an Administrative Assistant. Midaris, was an active member of the Reaching Out for Jesus Christian Center (ROJCC) in Brodheadsville, Pennsylvania. Midaris maintained and served faithfully on two auxiliaries. She became an Evangelist of the ROJCC in 2001 and has faithfully served on the Evangelist Board until her death. She visited the sick and shut in and very attentive to the seniors in her church. Midaris sang with the ROJCC Adult Ensemble. She sang soprano and sang very well. We can safely say with assurance that Midaris' life was hid in Christ;


